Radon Pipes

In our units, Radon piping comes out of the basement floor in one of two ways:

- 1. There is a pipe coming up through the basement floor from under the poured concrete with a cap on it. If you have this condition, your unit passed all radon tests and is free of radon, within the standards in place at the time of the testing.
- 2. The pipe coming out of the basement floor will continue up and out to the atmosphere with an exhaust fan to pull the radon out. If your unit has this condition, your unit failed the radon test and was upgraded to meet the standards in place at the time of the testing.

Slider Doors – Winter Position

In November to prepare for the winter snow, push the screen door of your sliders all the way over to one side, so your slider door (egress) is clear. Otherwise, the screen may trap and freeze accumulating snow and ice between the screen and the door preventing you from exiting.
